

History of GCISD Bond Elections (Past 22 years)

- ✦ May 1987 – One proposition of \$34 million
 - 914 - 59% for
 - 628 - 41% against

- ✦ March 1991 – Two propositions
 - Proposition 1 \$14.9 million
 - 1,244 - 70% for
 - 532 - 30% against
 - Proposition 2 \$4.65 million (stadium and aquatics center)
 - 961 – 55% for
 - 800 – 45% against

- ✦ November 1993 – Three propositions
 - Proposition 1 (new high school) \$27.8 million
 - 2,051 - 55% for
 - 1621 - 45% against
 - Proposition 2 (3 new elementary schools) \$21.3 million
 - 2,620 - 70% for
 - 1,081 - 30% against
 - Proposition 3 (renovations, additions, and technology for existing schools)
 - 2,131 - 58% for
 - 1,529 - 42% against

- ✦ September 1998 – One proposition of \$134 million (repair, renovation, upgrade, addition, expansion, construction and acquisition of school building sites, and purchase of technology)
 - 2,017 - 69% for
 - 896 - 31% against

- ✦ September 2005 – One proposition of \$107.9 million (construction, acquisition, additions, and renovations of facilities, necessary sites, new elementary school, purchase new buses, vehicles, and technology)
 - 2,298 - 68% for
 - 1,056 - 32% against
